Jim's cycling team GP VeloTek features one of the Midwest's most ambitious junior cycling teams.

Race: The Velotek Grand Prix is a time based stage race. Completion of each stage is required to race subsequent stages. Races will be held rain or shine. Promoter reserves the right to adjust start times and distances, alter or change courses, cancel and/or combine categories and prize lists as deemed necessary on the day of the race. Parents or guardians must sign release form for racers under age 18. Complete race info and post event results available by visiting www.velotek.com.

Registration: Pre-register online at <http://www.Active.com/>, search events for 'velotek'. Number pickup and registration available 6:30-9:00 p.m. along with pizza and festivities, Friday April 24 at Sunflower Outdoor & Bike (<http://sunfloweroutdoorandbike.com/>) 804 Massachusetts St. in downtown Lawrence or race day from 7-8 AM at the Prologue Course at Clinton State Park. Pre-registration & early number pickup is encouraged and greatly appreciated.

Entry Fee: \$69 (\$49 for Cat 5's) for the race weekend, Juniors & Youth race FREE in their age category. \$10 late fee for Saturday a.m. registration. Entry fee includes a \$3/day USA Cycling Insurance fee, \$1 KCA fee, and Clinton Lake Handicap Fund donation.

Rules: All USA Cycling (USAC) (www.usacycling.org) rules apply. USAC approved helmets must be worn at all times. Junior gears enforced, blocked gears ok. Composite teams not allowed in Cat 3 & 4 Team prizes, jerseys and license must match and a team must enter no more than 20 riders/category and finish at least three riders in the General Classification (GC) to qualify. Sign-in required between 1 hour to 15min prior to Criterium and Road Race starts. The Technical Race Guide is available by visiting www.velotek.com and contains the complete set of race regulations and procedures that riders are responsible for reading.

Licenses: All riders must present a valid USAC license in order to compete. Onsite one day licenses are \$10/day.

Prizes: Prizes may be paid in cash and/or check. Race winners or their representatives must be present at the awards ceremony immediately following the conclusion of the Sunday's races on April 26th to collect prizes. Additionally, prizes may be picked up within 14 days by contacting Revolution Racing, otherwise prizes will be subject to forfeit. The top three Men's 40+ Masters in the Cat 3 & 4 fields will receive an additional bonus prize based on their relative rank with each other in the GC.

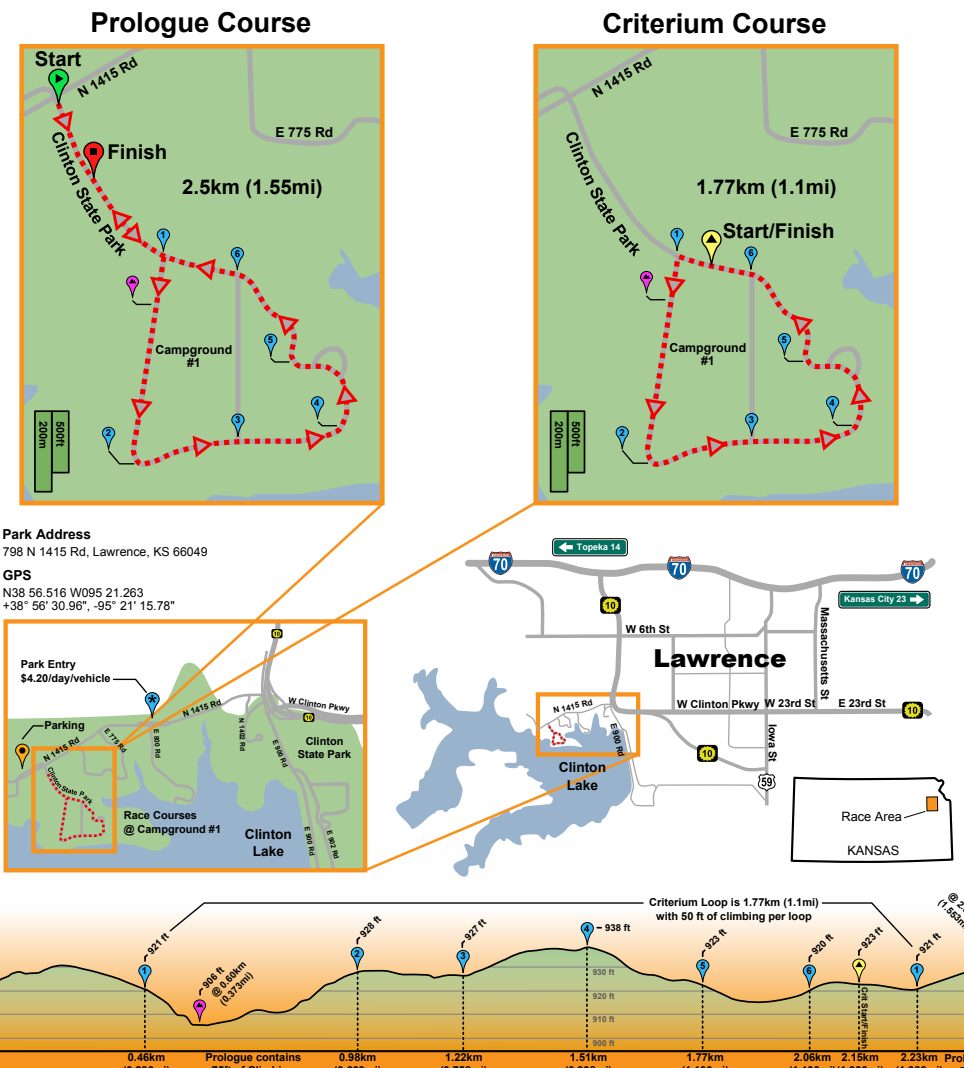

Race Location

The criterium and prologue courses are located in Campground #1 within Clinton State Park which is immediately southwest of Lawrence Kansas. Entry to the park is via N 1415 Rd located just north of the intersection of Clinton Parkway and K10 on E 900 Rd. Access to the race requires a one day park entry fee of \$4.20 per vehicle or an annual park pass.
